Following the MIFE Conference on 18 November 2024, this year's **MIFE Early Career Workshop** will take place on **19–20 November 2024**. For this workshop, we invite **early career researchers** (e.g. doctoral students, post-docs and assistant professors in their early career phase) **from all fields related to financial literacy and financial education** to submit their full papers. Related fields include (but are not limited to!) economics, household finance, economics and business education, and psychology.

EARLY CAREER RESEARCH PRIZE ON FINANCIAL LITERACY

Jointly with the sponsor **Deutsche Bundesbank**, we will award the **Early Career Research Prize on Financial Literacy** (up to two prizes for €2,500 each) for outstanding contributions among the submitted papers.

Acceptance decisions will be communicated by the end of September.
